

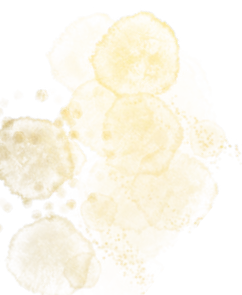

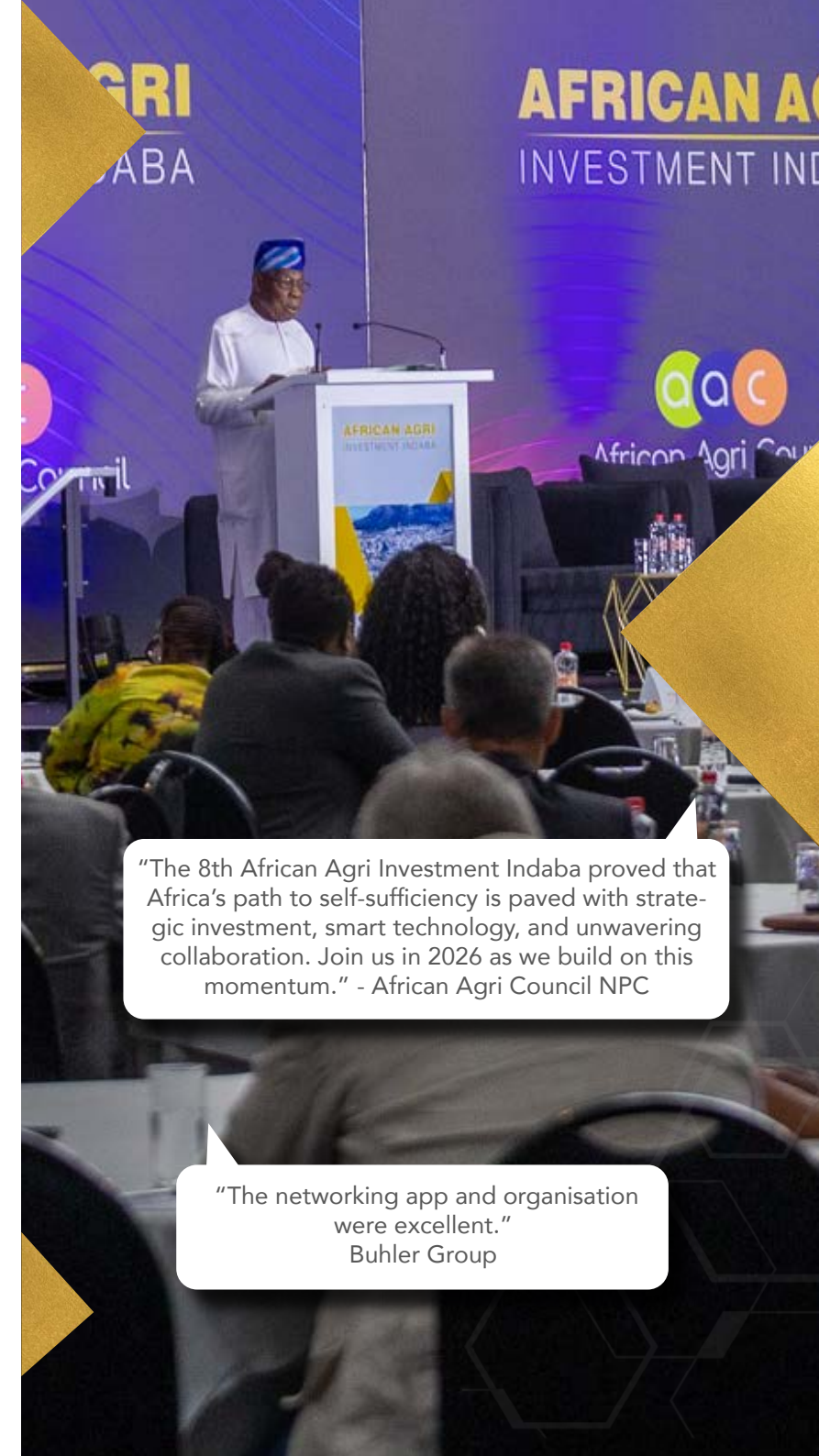

A total of 257 companies were present, showcasing strong engagement across local and international agribusiness communities.

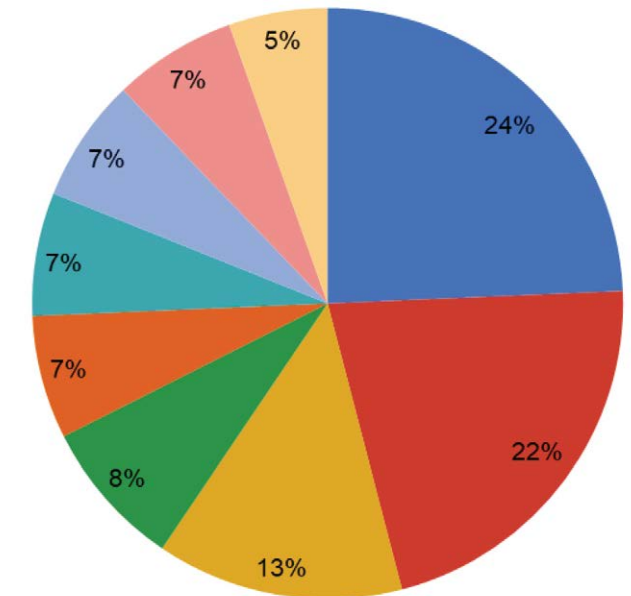
SECTOR PARTICIPATION:

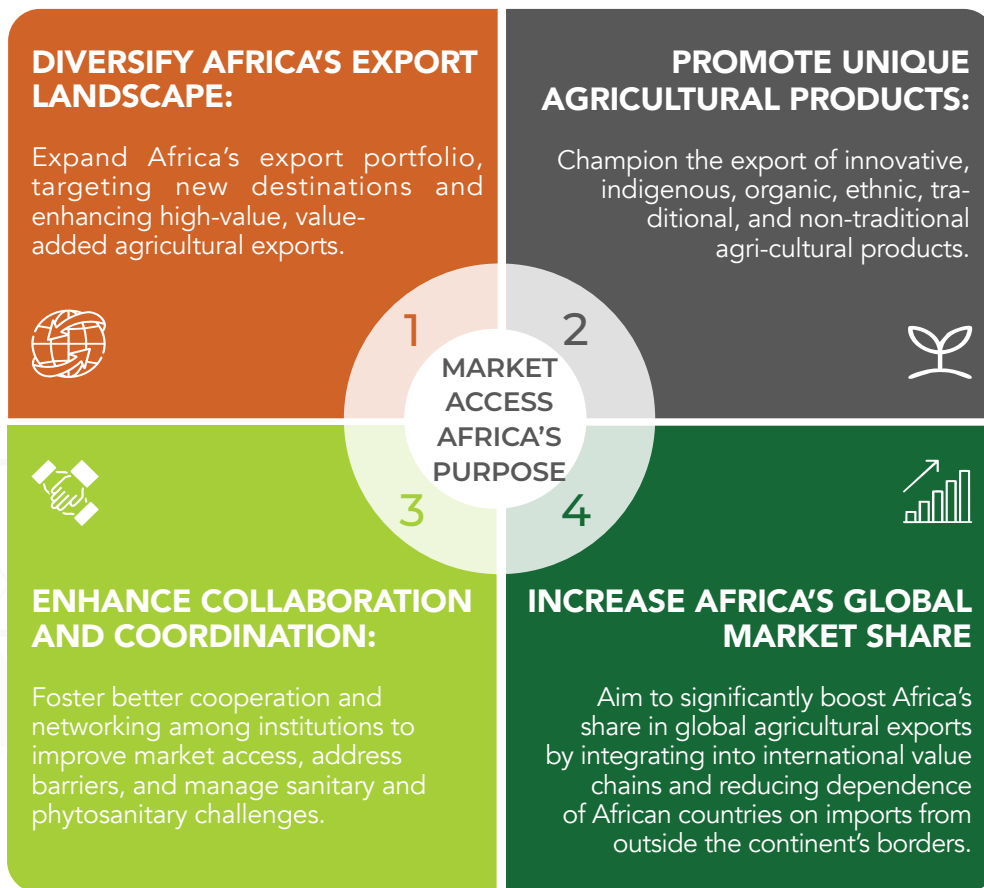
